OFFICE-ORDER

This is for information of all BDS students that as per Dental Council of India, New Delhi and Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur regulations, 75% attendance (both theory & practical) is compulsory for eligibility to appear in University Exams. It is also compulsory to appear in all 3 internal assessment exams. The internal assessment marks sent to the university are calculated as per following formula.


Marks distribution of internal assessment

Theory internal assessment (10)	Attendance Theory (max marks allotted =4) Calculated as follows: $4 \times \% \text{ theory attendance} / 100 +$	Average percentage of three internal theory assessments (max marks allotted =2x3=6) Calculated as follows: $6 \times \% \text{ Average percentage of three internal assessments} / 100$
Practical internal assessment (10)	Attendance practical (max marks allotted=4) Calculated as follows: $4 \times \% \text{ theory attendance} / 100 +$	Average percentage of three internal practical assessments (max marks allotted =2x3=6) Calculated as follows: $6 \times \% \text{ Average percentage of three internal assessments} / 100$

Henceforth, they are instructed to be **regular in classes** and **secure good marks** in all the 3 internal assessment exams so as to achieve a good internal assessment score before university examinations.

Note:


1. Candidates, at the end of academic session, having attendance less than required 75% in theory and practical / clinics separately in each subject will not be allowed to appear in University exams.
2. Third year BDS students should have 75% attendance in Gen. Medicine, Gen. Surgery & Oral Pathology. In other 8 dental subjects, it should not be less than 70%. However, at the time of appearing in university examination in these subjects, the aggregate percentage of attendance in these subjects should be 75 % separately theory & clinics.
