

1. Establishment of NSS (National Service Scheme) Cell:

As per the Sanction order No.F.96/NSS/2020 dated 19-01-2021 for Surendera Dental College & Research Institute, NSS (National Service Scheme) Cell, Surendera Dental College & Research Institute has been established on 20-01-2021.

2. About NSS (National Service Scheme):

The National Service Scheme is an Indian government-sponsored public service program conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India. Popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year in 1969. Aimed at developing student's personality through community service. It provides opportunity to the student youth of 11th & 12th class of schools at +2 Board level and student youth of Technical Institution, Graduate & Post Graduate at colleges and University level of India to take part in various government led community service activities & programmes. The sole aim of the NSS is to provide hands on experience to young students in delivering community service.

The students participating in its activities work with the people of the society in the interest of the society. Literacy related work, environmental protection, Health and sanitation, assistance to the victims of emergency or natural disaster etc. By virtue of the social work from the student's life, the qualities of social service or national service are developed in them. To become an ideal citizen, it is necessary to develop these qualities.

The National Service Scheme of Sharda University is constantly working to make students aware of social problems and motivate them in creative work to solve them.

3. Motto: The motto of National Service Scheme is **NOT ME BUT YOU**

The Motto of NSS "Not Me But You", reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service. NSS helps the student's development & appreciation to other person's point of view and show consideration towards other living beings.
