

2.	<p>Background/Introduction</p> <p>Basic Life Support (BLS) is defined as <i>"maintaining airway patency and supporting breathing and the circulation without the use of equipment other than a protective device"</i></p> <p>Basic Life Support is used to help patients who have suffered a cardiac arrest. This means their heart has stopped beating so blood is not being pumped around the body.</p> <p>Basic Life Support involves performing chest compressions and rescue breaths. By performing chest compressions you are pushing blood around the body, and rescue breaths push oxygen into the lungs. This process keeps the vital organs supplied with blood.</p> <p>Anyone can learn to perform Basic Life Support (BLS) and this is often a core topic on first aid courses. Prompt BLS is incredibly important when a patient suffers a cardiac arrest.</p> <p>Once emergency medical services arrive they will continue Basic Life Support whilst they carry out more advanced interventions (termed 'Advanced Life Support' – ALS).</p> <p>Advanced cardiac life support, or advanced cardiovascular life support, often referred to by its acronym, "ACLS", refers to a set of clinical algorithms for the urgent treatment of <u>cardiac arrest</u>, <u>stroke</u>, <u>myocardial infarction</u> (also known as a heart attack), and other life-threatening cardiovascular emergencies.</p> <p>Only qualified health care providers can provide ACLS, as it requires the ability to manage the person's airway, initiate vascular access, read and interpret <u>electrocardiograms</u>, and understand emergency pharmacology. These providers include <u>physicians</u>, <u>pharmacists</u>, <u>paramedics</u>, advanced practice providers (physician assistants and nurse practitioners), <u>respiratory therapists</u>, and <u>nurses</u>.</p> <p>Other emergency responders may also be trained.</p>

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	<p>One of the most important single determinants for quality healthcare provision is the competence of medical/dental practitioner, particularly, when an unexpected emergency arises (Ibnerasa, Hashmi, & Chaudrhy, 2011). Dentist sometimes have to face similar medical emergency requiring CPR during dental procedures. 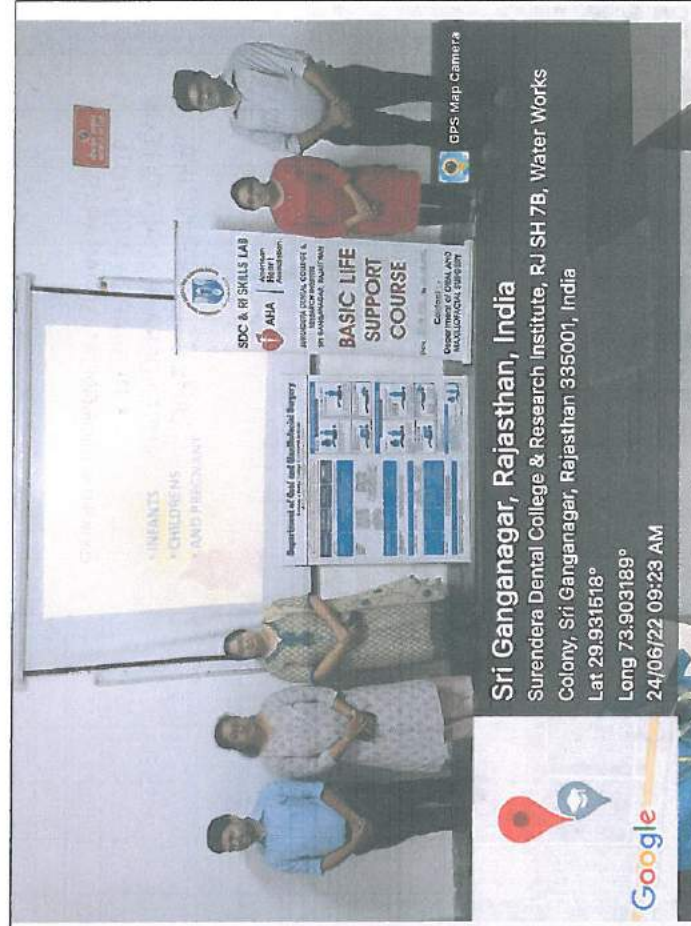

Oral and Maxillofacial surgeon's Day (13th February 2023)

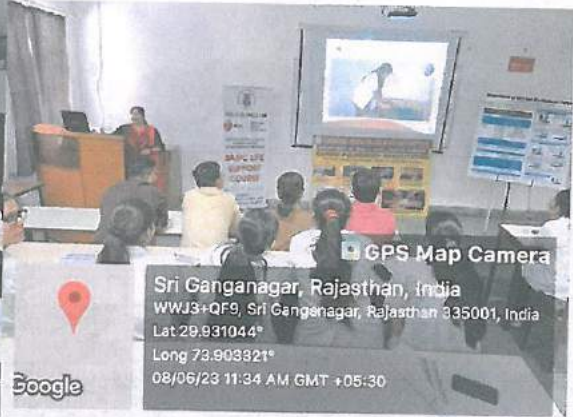
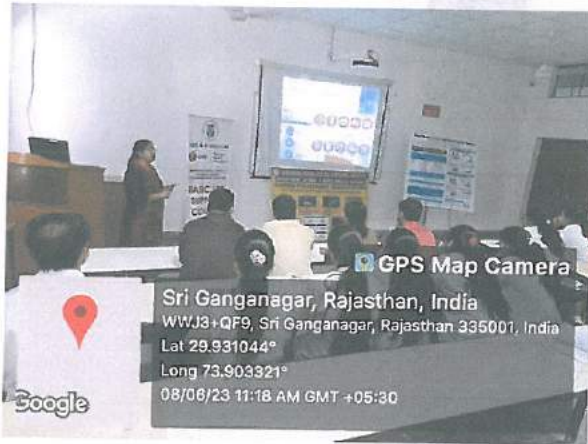
