

8. ALLOTMENT OF SEATS THROUGH ON-LINE ALLOTMENT PROCESS

Allotment of seats through 1st round on-line allotment process of all NEET qualified and registered candidates through NEET 2022 result shall be conducted strictly in accordance with the merit list prepared on the basis of All India Merit in NEET 2022, the order of choices / options filled in by the candidates in the on-line application form **(Candidates are advised to fill the choices very carefully after referring the Fees displayed at the time of choice filling and also College Information Sheet of the respective college).**

Round 2 of State NEET UG (Medical/Dental) Counseling 2022 shall be held off-line.

The allotment shall be processed based on the merit corresponding to following minimum percentile obtained in NEET 2022 for all categories (as per NMC guidelines) and the order of choices / options filled in by the candidates in the on-line form.

As per the press release dated 07.09.2022 by National Testing Agency:

ST-STA	40th percentile and above (93 marks and above)
SC/ST/ST-STA/OBC/MBC-PwD	40th percentile and above (93 marks and above)

SELECTION OF STUDENTS

- i. The selection of students to a Medical / Dental College shall be based solely on the All India merit of the candidate through NEET 2022.
- ii. To be eligible for MBBS & BDS Admissions 2022, the candidate must have fulfilled the eligibility criteria as mentioned in this booklet.
- iii. The eligible qualified candidates in the NEET 2022 will be admitted in the order of merit for the general as well as reserved seats excepting the seats belonging to the category of the sub-clause 'd' of clause-4 (regarding defence/paramilitary wards) in which case it would be priority-cum-merit.

The allotment of seat to a candidate shall remain provisional till verification of original documents and fulfilment of medical fitness criteria, at the allotted college.

A candidates will be deemed to have joined an institution once his/her original documents are submitted, reported physically at the allotted institution and have deposited the requisite fee.

8. ALLOTMENT OF SEATS

The allotment of seats shall be conducted strictly in accordance with the merit list prepared on the basis of All India Merit in NEET 2023 (of NEET 2023 qualified and State registered candidates), the order of choices / options filled in by the candidates in the application form (**Candidates are advised to fill the choices very carefully after referring the Fees displayed at the time of choice filling and also College Information Sheet of the respective college**).

Round 3 of State NEET UG (Medical/Dental) Counseling 2023 shall be held off-line.

The allotment shall be processed based on the merit corresponding to following minimum percentile obtained in NEET 2023 for all categories (as per NMC guidelines) and the order of choices / options filled in by the candidates in the on-line form.

The allotment of seat to a candidate shall remain provisional till verification of original documents, eligibility and fulfilment of medical fitness criteria, at the allotted college.

A candidates will be deemed to have joined an institution once his/her original documents are submitted, reported physically at the allotted institution and have deposited the requisite fee.
