Criteria and methodology to identify slow and advanced performers

Guidelines to be followed by each department to measure students' achievements

- 1. Adopt measurable criteria to identify slow performers
 Students securing below 25% marks in the first internal examination
- 2. Adopt measurable criteria to identify advance learners Students securing more than 75%
- 3. Remedial measures for slow performers:
 - These students should be followed at the department level by faculty member
 - The remedial classes should have to be conducted in addition to regular classes for slow performers by displaying time table and taking attendance
 - The remedial classes should also be conducted for students who will be unable to secure passing marks in university examination
 - Special attention should be given to these students from subject experts, through regular interactive session
 - Parent- teachers meeting: They should be regularly held subject wise wherein, the strength and weakness, attendance and academic performances will be discussed with appropriate counseling and remedial measures.

<u>Outcome measures:</u> The outcome of slow performers in internal examinations, preliminary examinations and summative assessments will have to be analyzed to ascertain their consistency in improvement.
