

1.	<p>Name & Level of events:</p> <p>WORLD HEAD AND NECK CANCER DAY-2022</p> <p>Level- College Level</p>
2.	<p>Background/Introduction</p> <p>The 27th of July each year has been declared by the International Federation of Head and Neck Oncology Societies as World Head and Neck Cancer Day. There are over 500,000 cases and 200,000 head and neck cancer-related deaths globally each year. With greater awareness of the signs and symptoms to look out for, some of these cases are preventable. Oral and pharyngeal cancer is the 6th most common malignancy reported worldwide and one with high mortality ratios among all malignancies. India has a high disease burden of head neck cancers. The principal cause of Head neck cancer is the consumption of tobacco and alcohol. Tobacco can be smoked in the form of cigarettes and bidi or chewed in the form of gutka, pan, pan masala etc. Head and neck cancer can be cured if detected early and treated adequately in a timely manner. Multidisciplinary management by site-specific oncologists has shown the best outcomes. Surgery remains the cornerstone of treatment for the majority of the Head Neck sites. However, radiation therapy with or without chemotherapy plays an important role, especially in advanced stages. Often a combined modality treatment is required when the tumor is stage III or IV. Chemotherapy alone or immunotherapy is needed in advanced, unresectable or metastatic disease.</p>

Prompt BLS is incredibly important when a patient suffers a cardiac arrest.</p> <p>Once emergency medical services arrive they will continue Basic Life Support whilst they carry out more advanced interventions (termed 'Advanced Life Support' – ALS).</p> <p>Advanced cardiac life support, or advanced cardiovascular life support, often referred to by its acronym, "ACLS", refers to a set of clinical algorithms for the urgent treatment of <u>cardiac arrest, stroke, myocardial infarction</u> (also known as a heart attack), and other life-threatening cardiovascular emergencies.</p> <p>Only qualified health care providers can provide ACLS, as it requires the ability to manage the person's airway, initiate vascular access, read and interpret <u>electrocardiograms</u>, and understand emergency pharmacology. These providers include <u>physicians, pharmacists, paramedics, advanced practice providers (physician assistants and nurse practitioners), respiratory therapists, and nurses</u>. Other emergency responders may also be trained.</p>

	<p>One of the most important single determinants for quality healthcare provision is the competence of medical/dental practitioner, particularly, when an unexpected emergency arises (Ibnerasa, Hashmi, & Chaudhry, 2011). Cardiac arrest is a medical emergency requiring immediate Cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for survival (Li et al., 2013). Dentist sometimes have to face similar medical emergency requiring CPR during dental procedures. Such emergencies most likely occur during and after local anesthesia, primarily during tooth extraction and endodontics (Carvalho, Costa, & Marcelo, 2008).</p> <p>According to Carvalho et al 2008, the frequency of medical emergencies during dental practice are increasing as dentists are seeing an increasing number of elderly and medically compromised patients and are performing more sedation procedures. This justifies the need for every dental practitioner to be able to perform the basics of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR): chest compression and rescue breaths (Laurent et al., 2009), especially when chances of survival of the patient of cardiac arrest are reduced by 7 to 10 percent every minute if CPR is not done on time (Carvalho et al., 2008).</p>

Osteomyelitis of the maxilla is now a rare event with the advent of antibiotics. The two predominant causes are odontogenic infections and sinusitis. Immunocompromised states such as diabetes, HIV, and malnutrition increase the risk of osteomyelitis. It is important to recognize this early as it is a difficult entity to treat with potentially serious consequences.

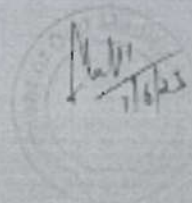

Background Introduction Dental age (DA) estimations in children are based on clinical examinations that include recordings of tooth eruption or observations of the tooth formation stages using radiographs. One of the most widely applied methods is the Demirjian's system, which was first described in 1973 and was based on a sample of French-Canadian children. Demirjian's method is theoretically based on eight developmental stages ranging from crown and root formation to apex closure of the seven left permanent mandibular teeth. The score of each stage is allocated, and the sum of the scores provides an evaluation of the subject's dental maturity. The dental maturity score (DMS) can be converted into the DA using available tables.

2.	Background/Introduction Compressed gases expose users to both chemical and physical hazards. Gases contained within cylinders can be toxic, flammable, oxidizing, corrosive, inert, or a combination of these hazards. Because the pressurized chemical is released in gaseous form, a leak from the cylinder, regulator, or any part of the system used to deliver the gas can quickly contaminate a large area. Therefore, it is necessary to be familiar with the chemical hazards of the gas and possibility of asphyxiation. In addition to the chemical hazards, there are hazards from the gas pressure and the physical weight of the cylinder. A gas cylinder falling over can burst chemical containers and crush feet. The cylinder can itself become a dangerous propelled object if its valve is broken off. Appropriate care in the handling and storage of compressed gas cylinders is essential and information is provided below. So seminar and training session was planned.
